

2010 BALTIMORE COUNTY SMALL BOAT RACING PROGRAM

PROGRAM: For 2010, Baltimore County smallboat racing will be conducted off Rocky Point Park, through a recreation council program offered by the Baltimore County Sailing Center, under race management from Glenmar Sailing Assn. Racing will be conducted according to the US SAILING publication The Racing Rules of Sailing. Boat owner participants can bring and rig their privately owned boats each evening (transient) or keep rigged boats there (onsite), space allowing. All boats must qualify, will race, and start under Portsmouth Handicap, except Thistles, (other classes may apply) which will be scored & start one-design.

LOCATION & DATES: Races are held every Thursday evening from 5/6 through 9/10 (1st horn 18:30 hrs.), Saturday, 6/5 (1st horn 11:00 hrs.) for the GSA Annual Small Boat Regatta (3 races), Sunday 9/12 (1st horn 10:00 hrs.) for the Sunday Fall 3 Race, at the Baltimore County Sailing Center, located in Rocky Point Park.

- ALL SKIPPERS SHALL:**
- 1) Have registered and paid their program fee to the BCSC
 - 2) Abide by the 2010 US SAILING Racing Rules of Sailing (including club membership requirements)
 - 3) Race a conforming class legal boat (Thistle's require 2010 class membership)

COSTS: BALTIMORE COUNTY SAILING CENTER

Racing Fees for this program cover the seasonal site storage/ramp cost to Baltimore Co., recreation council participant fees, use of chase boats by RC, facility charges, RC equipment costs, and some funds for social events. \$35 of this fee is paid to Glenmar SA to administer the program. Go to: www.bcsailing.org after March 1, 2010, to register. All boats must be a part of the racing program and participate on a regular basis. No increase over 2009 rates are anticipated
